2023 MAYOR'S TELSTRA INNOVATION AWARDS

The MTIA aim to encourage innovation and creativity through the development of a new innovative idea, creative concept or business solution. This could be a new app, new concept in social media, new gaming technology, a solution to an environmental issue or a local Sunshine Coast problem that needs a solution.

The competition for the 2023 Mayor's Telstra Innovation Awards is now open!

- The awards are open to students from Years 9 to 12 in teams of up to three. Teams must be from high schools that are located within the Sunshine Coast Local Government Area.
- There is no limit to the number of teams that can enter from each school.
- Phase 1 of the MTIA commences on Wednesday
 15th February 2023. Teams will have 10 weeks to develop an original innovative idea, creative concept or business solution.
- Entries for Phase 1 of the MTIA close 11.59pm,
 Thursday 27th April 2023.
- A judging panel including the Mayor Mark Jamieson will review all of the entries and shortlist the finalist teams who will be announced on Friday 5th May 2023.
- During Phase 2, teams have a further seven weeks to develop their original idea or concept. During this phase, teams will attend dedicated mentoring sessions with industry experts and have the opportunity to be coached and further develop their idea.
- Entries for Phase 2 of the MTIA close at 11.59pm, on Thursday 22nd June 2023.
- A judging panel including the Mayor Mark Jamieson will review the entries and allocate scores based on the MTIA judging criteria outlined in the terms and conditions.
- Live Pitch and Awards Night will be held on Thursday 20th July 2023. The finalist teams will present their ideas or concept in a live 'pitch' to the judging panel and audience. Final scores for this presentation will be allocated and the winner of the 2023 Mayor's Telstra Innovation Awards appounced.
